



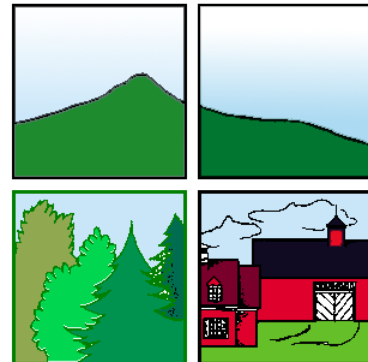
The Keene State College, Alumni Center is located on the corner of Main and Marlborough Streets in Keene.
