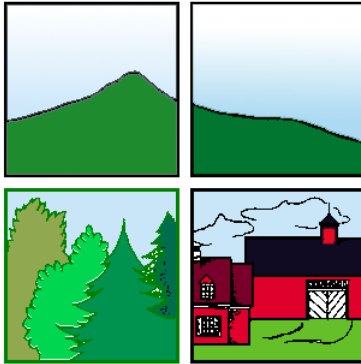

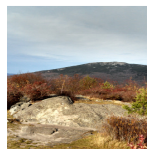

Program: Celebrating Monadnock

Alan Rumrill has been the Executive Director of the Historical Society of Cheshire County since 1983. In addition he has served as the Director of Davis Public Library in the Town of Stoddard where his family has lived since 1770. He has written seven books on regional art and history, including his most recent release *Ponds, Power and People: A History of Highland Lake*.

Among other things, Mount Monadnock has a great impact on both the character and heritage of our region. Mr. Rumrill will share thoughts and perspectives on the use of Mount Monadnock for marketing within the region and beyond.
