The Monadnock Region's Broadband Plan was developed as part of the New Hampshire Broadband Mapping and Planning Program, from 2010-2014 with the assistance of the Southwest Broadband Stakeholders Group. ### 4. New Hampshire Broadband Mapping and Planning Program Website
