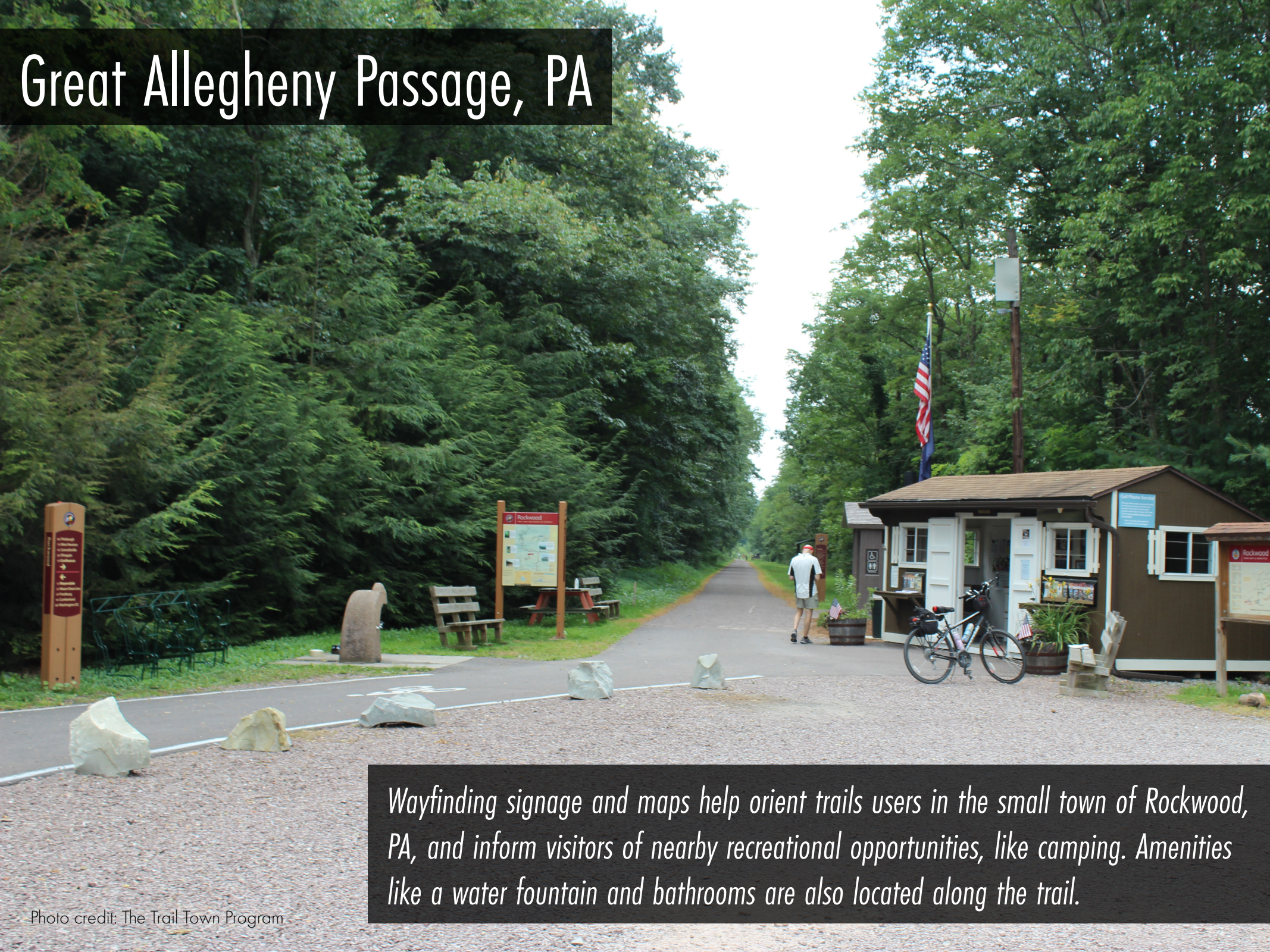

# Great Allegheny Passage, PA



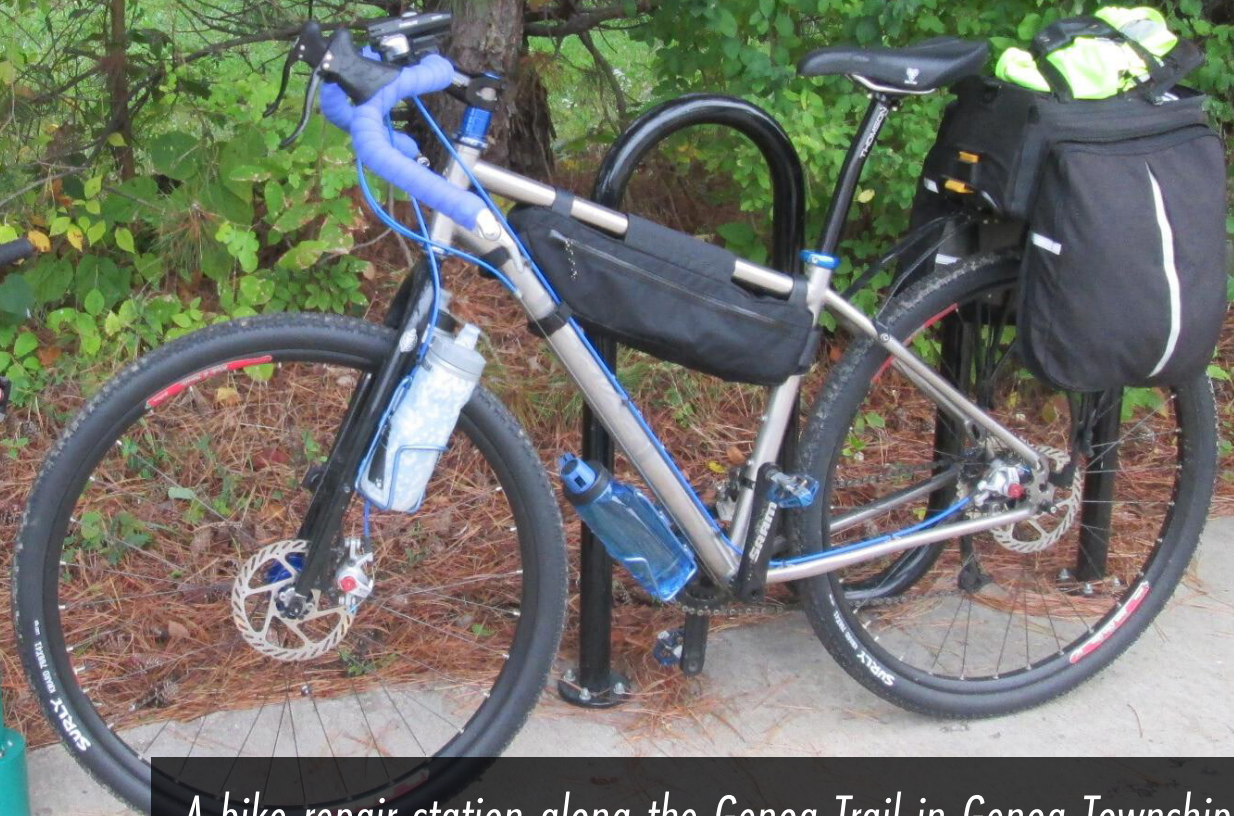
