The Southwest Region Planning Commission (SWRPC) is recruiting to fill a position focused on community and economic development. This position can be slotted as entry-, mid-, or senior-level depending on background and experience.

SWRPC is based in Keene, NH and serves 33 communities of the Monadnock Region. Duties to include work on a range of activities which comprise the agency work program. Specific programs include update and maintenance of the *Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy for Southwest NH* (<u>www.OurEconomy.info</u>) and Community Development Block Grant administration (CDBG), as well as contributing to projects which address housing, workforce, energy, and regional food systems. SWRPC utilizes a teamwork approach in serving its member municipalities and others, encourages coordination and collaboration among a range of stakeholders, and its work is grounded in sustainable planning principles.
