Request for Qualifications On-Call Engineering Services Southwest Region Planning Commission

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Date of Issue: February 25, 2022

Deadline for Submission: March 25, 2022

A. Project Description

The Southwest Region Planning Commission (SWRPC) is requesting statements of qualifications to provide on-call engineering services in support of transportation planning efforts throughout the SWRPC region. The efforts include scoping and developing preliminary cost estimates for transportation improvement projects that may be funded with local, state or federal funds (including Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration).

B. Scope of Services

SWRPC provides a wide variety of transportation planning services to its thirty-three member communities. Engineering services on an on-call basis may include, but are not limited to:

- Developing improvement concepts and providing planning-level engineering assistance for proposed transportation projects in the SWRPC region;
- Preparing preliminary cost estimates for projects and/or alternatives within projects; and
- Meeting with representatives of SWRPC member communities and staff on an as-needed basis to discuss work products.

Priority tasks will involve assisting SWRPC in evaluating project proposals for the FY 2025-2034 Ten

Year Transportation Improvement Plan. All work under the overall retainer agreement will be assigned by individual task orders negotiated on a lump sum basis. The overall retainer agreement will extend through June 30, 2023. The projected amount to be awarded under the overall retainer agreement will be \$20,000. At its discretion, SWRPC may choose to increase the budget available for on-call engineering services.

C. Statement of Qualifications Requirements

The firm, partnership, or individual interested in providing on-call engineering services to SWRPC must provide a Statement of Qualifications that includes the following:

- Name of the consulting firm, partnership, or individual with a brief history and description;
- Name, title and professional and educational qualifications, including appropriate state licenses and affiliations, of key personnel assigned to this project;
- Executive Summary demonstrating understanding of the request and the ability to complete similar projects within time constraints;
- Documentation of experience in local transportation planning/engineering;
- Documentation of experience working with federal transportation funds;
- Documentation that the firm, partnership, or individual has the staffing capacity necessary to perform the work in an adequate and appropriate timeframe;
- Description of the firm, partnership, or individual's three most current related projects with an outline of the level of involvement; and
- List of at least three (3) professional references, including name, title, contact information, and description of product provided (if clients) or relationship (if colleagues).

D. Review and Evaluation Process

The submissions will be reviewed by a selection committee comprised of SWRPC staff and representatives of the SWRPC Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC). An in-person or video interview (e.g. Zoom, etc.) may be requested prior to selection.

The evaluation criteria are as follows:

- Qualifications and experience of the personnel to be assigned to the project (20%);
- Professional competence as evidenced by the firm, partnership, or individual's three most current related projects and references (20%);
- Experience in scoping and developing cost estimates for federally-funded transportation improvement projects (20%);
- Demonstration that the firm, partnership, or individual has the staffing capacity necessary to perform on-call services in an adequate and appropriate timeframe (20%); and
- Clarity, completeness and conciseness of the Statement of Qualifications (20%).

All statements of qualifications must be received by SWRPC no later than March 25, 2022 at 5 p.m. Materials received after this time will not be accepted or reviewed. It is the intent of SWRPC to notify the selected firm, partnership or individual prior to April 22, 2022.

The expense of preparing and submitting a statement of qualifications is the sole responsibility of the firm, partnership or individual. SWRPC reserves the right to reject any and all proposals received, to negotiate with any qualified source, or to cancel in part or in its entirety this Request for Qualifications. This solicitation in no way obligates SWRPC to award a contract. Any contract awarded by SWRPC pursuant to this RfQ shall be subject to the provisions of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation's (NHDOT) Local Public Agency (LPA) Manual for the Development of Projects.

SWRPC will afford firms, partnerships, or individuals the full opportunity to submit proposals in response to this invitation and will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability in consideration of this award.
