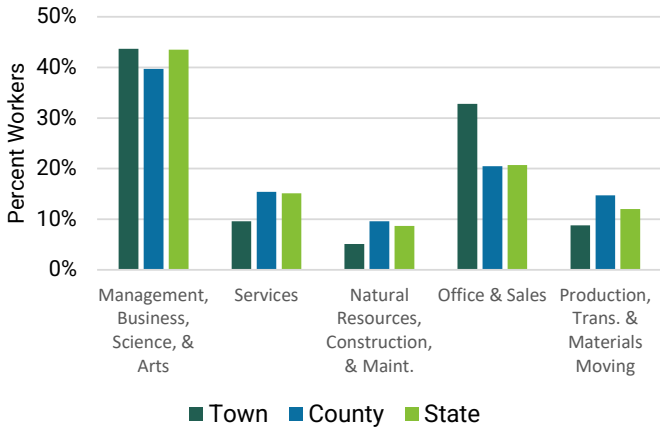

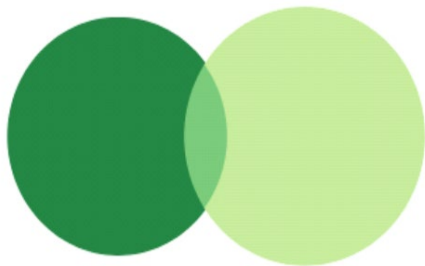

All Workers

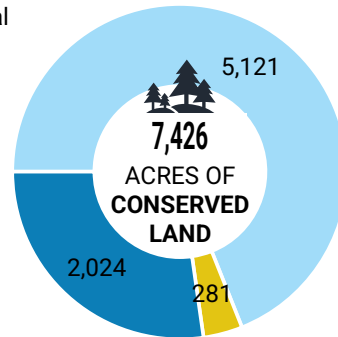

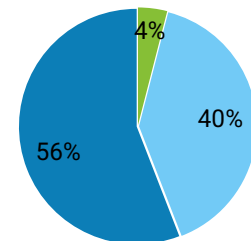
