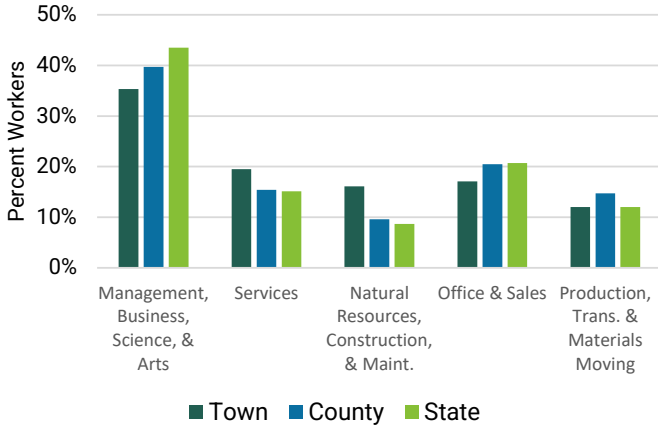

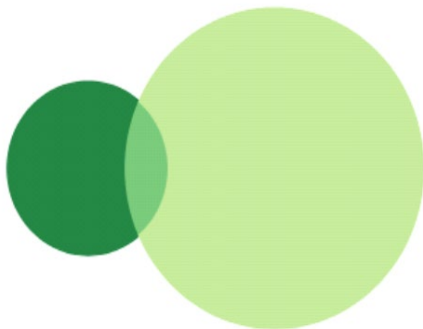


Where do Residents Work? % of Population

All Workers

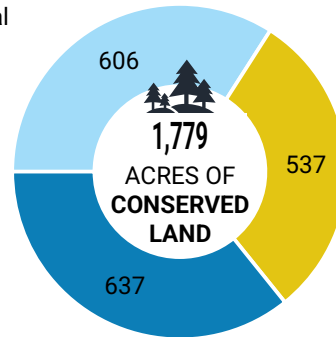

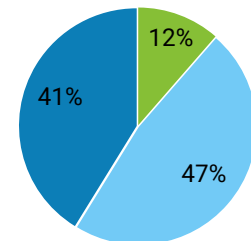
