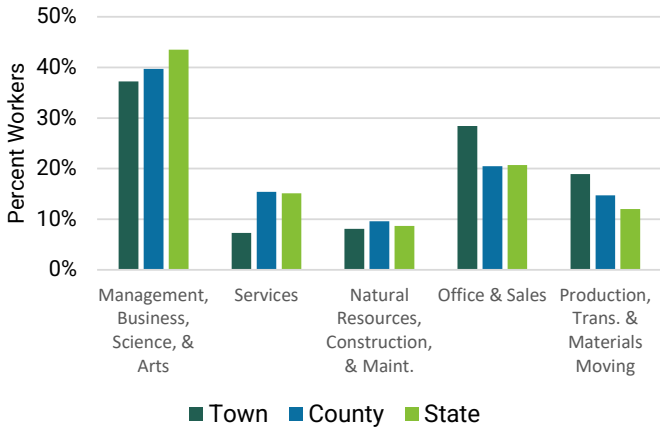

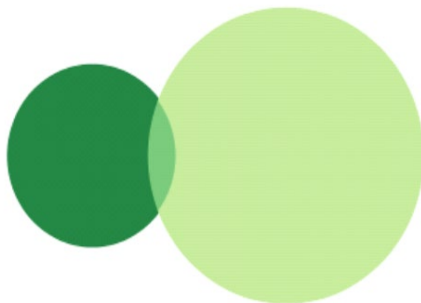

All Workers

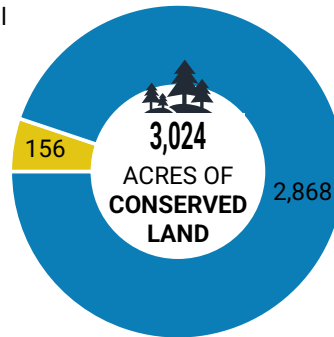

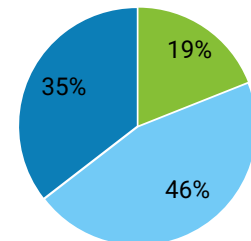
