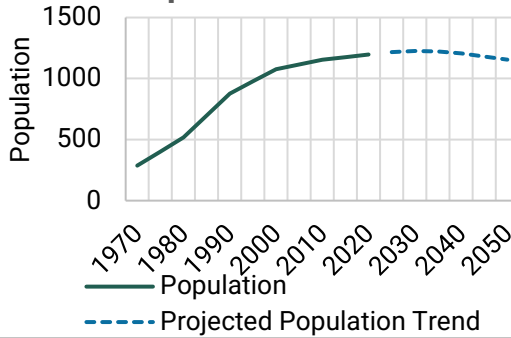

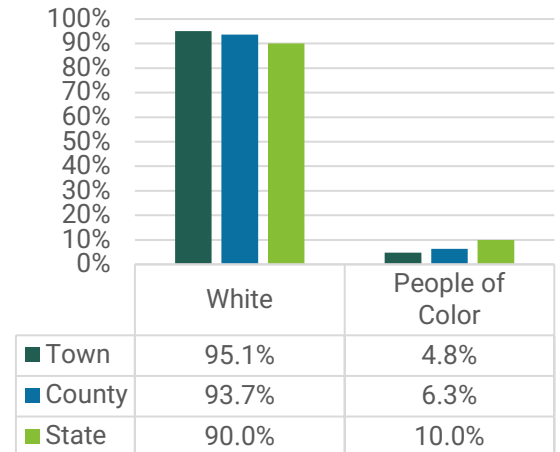

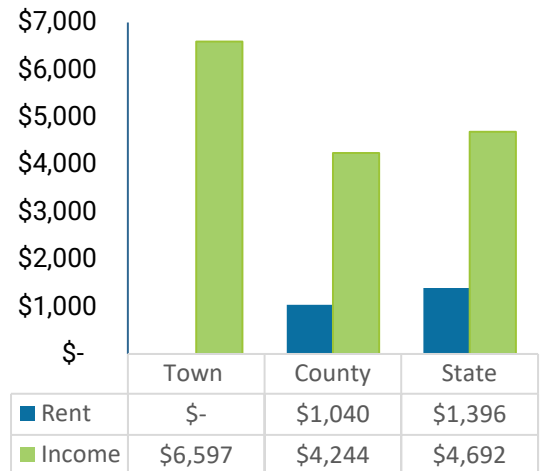

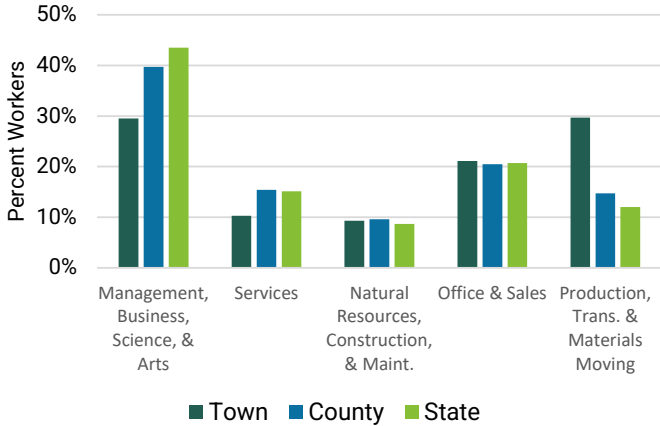

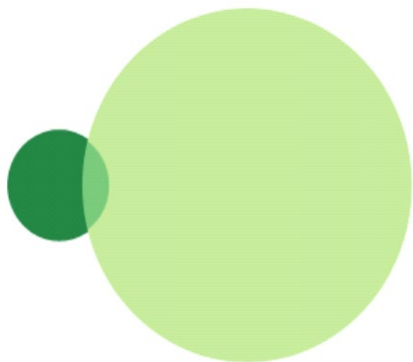

All Workers

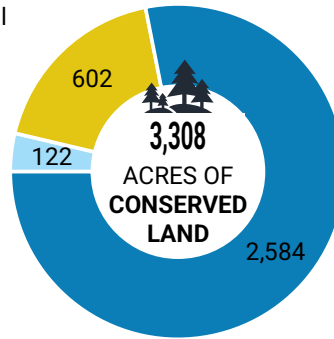

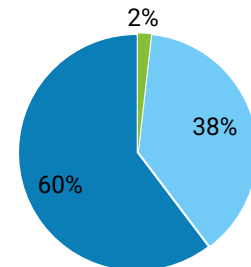
