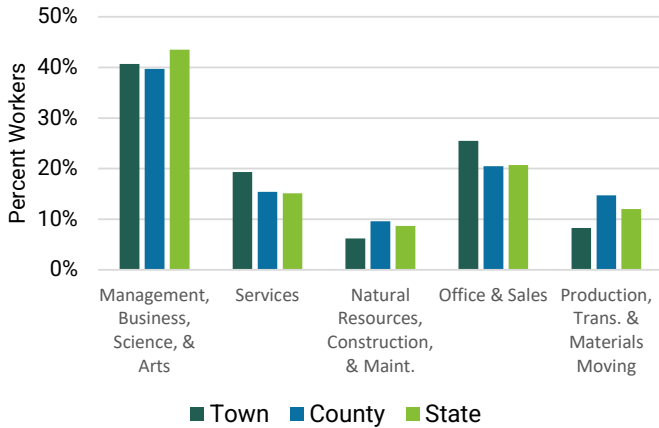

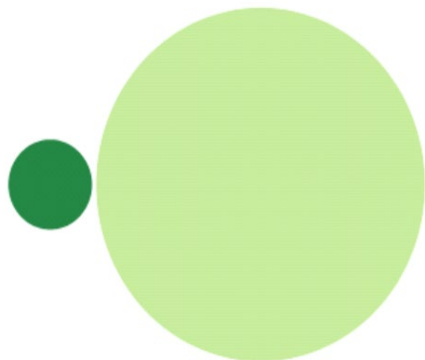
Where do Residents Work?

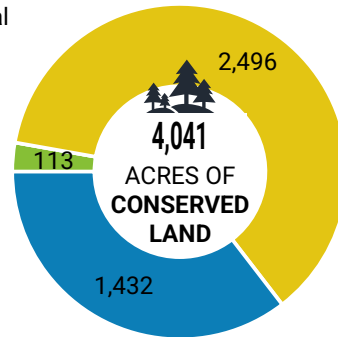
Inflow/Outflow Job Counts in 2021

Miles of Trails



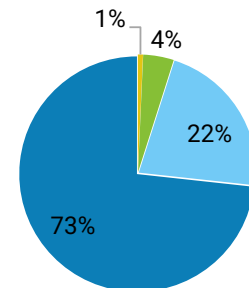
