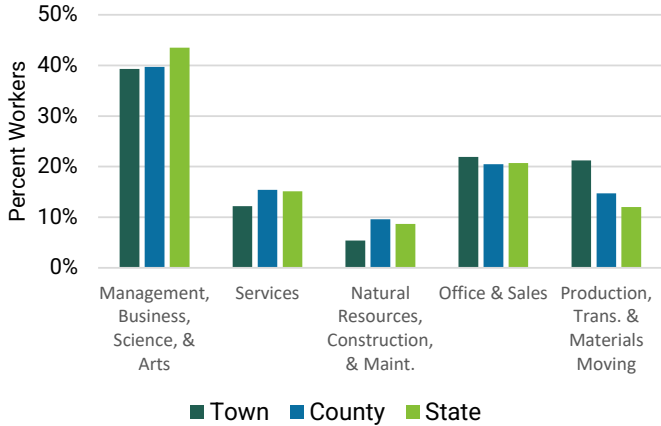

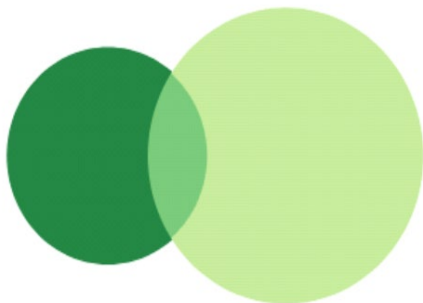

All Workers

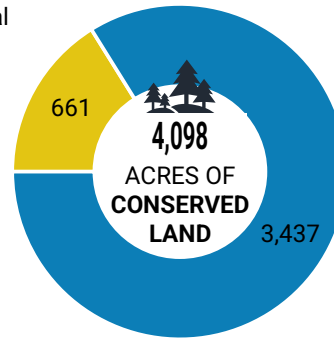

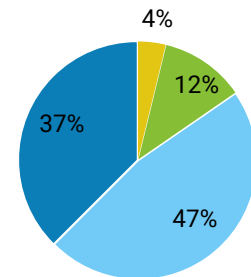
