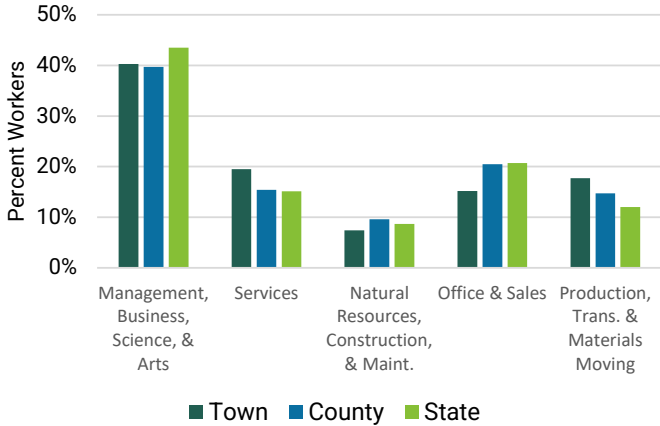

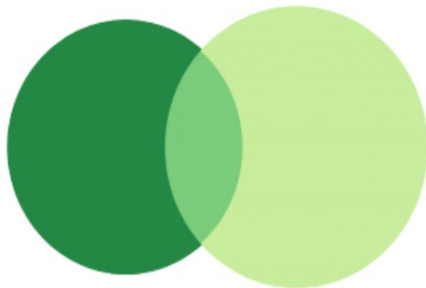

All Workers

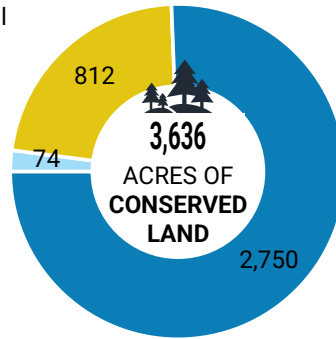

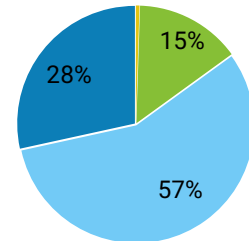
