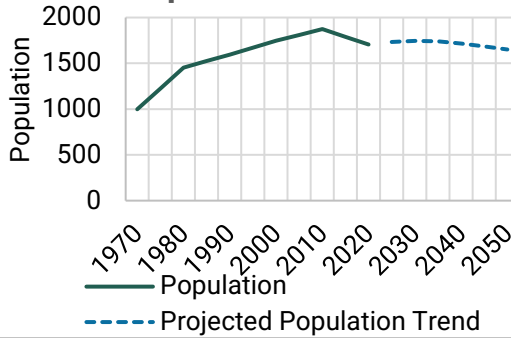

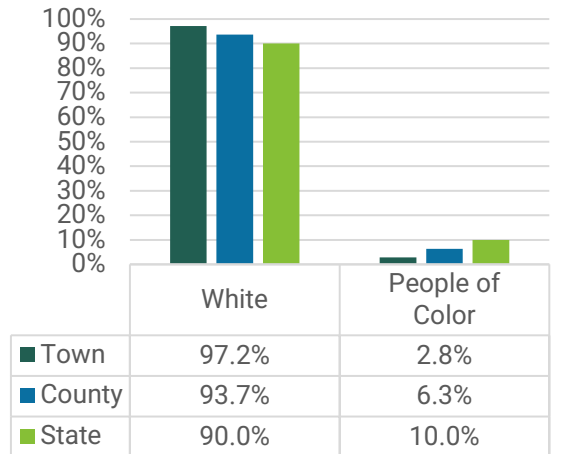

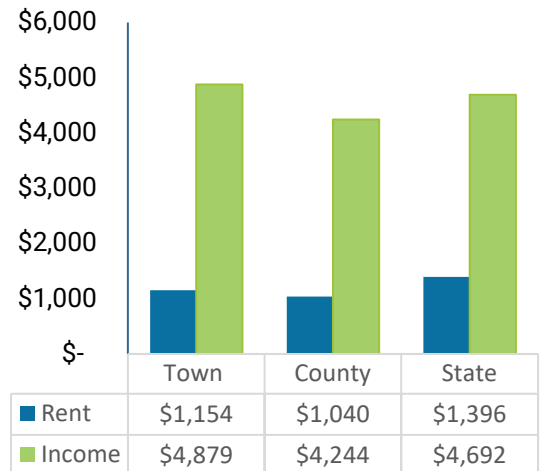

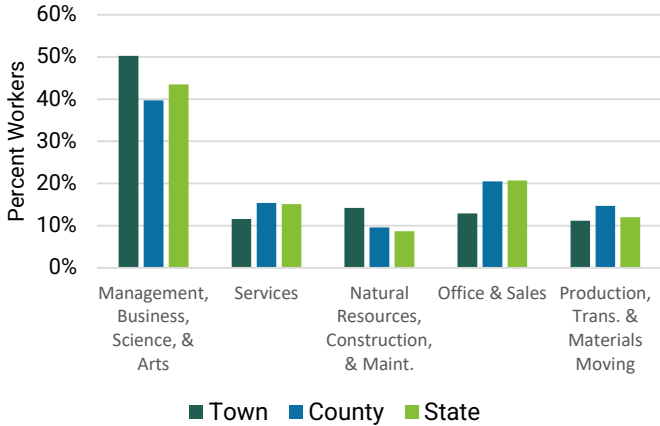

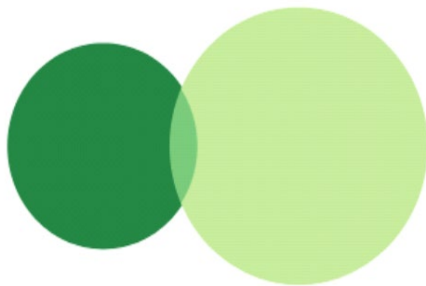


Where do Residents Work? % of Population

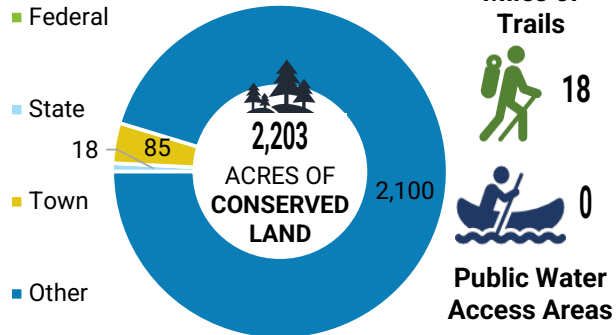
COMMUTING PATTERNS⁵

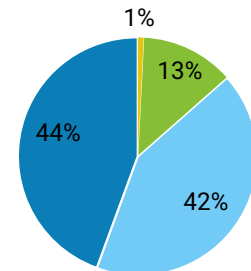
