In 2022, SWRPC published the [Microtransit Feasibility and Fixed Route Transit Service Plan Design Assistance Study](#). The study was conducted by transit consultant, [Via](#), on behalf of SWRPC, in partnership with Home Healthcare, Hospice, and Community Services (HCS) and the Monadnock Regional Coordinating Council (MRCC). In 2024, SWRPC launched a follow-up project to identify a transit operating model and managing entity to support a more innovative, coordinated and resilient transportation system for Greater Keene and other parts of Southwest New Hampshire.
